

The Hercules calf puller provides a new approach to difficult calvings. The ratchet type jack has 3 separate hook attachments, one for each of the two obstetrical leg chains, and a separate hook for the head sling. Two of these hooks pull alternately along the shaft by moving the jack handle back and forth. Even a very difficult birth can be helped by using this zig zag pull.

To release under pressure, walk jack backward by releasing one catch at a time.

The extra long shaft (65") can be disassembled in the middle, and is made from thick walled steel pipe. Deep grooves guarantee against slipping.

Breech is supplied with an easy to clean adjustable chain.

Congratulations on your purchase of our J-99, Hercules calf puller. This is the original model as designed in West Germany. The original unit has been modified and strengthened to fit the demands of the U.S. market.

The Hercules calf puller offers the user the following features:

- 1. The shaft screws apart at the breech and mid-point for easy storage. Be sure the shaft is screwed all the way together at the mid-point or the shaft may bend.
- 2. The jack assembly has three hooks. By putting one chain on one side hook and another chain on the other side hook, you will be pulling one leg at a time. This alternating or "zig-zag" pull actually "walks" the calf out. This causes less strain on the pulled calf.
- 3. The middle hook can be used for a chain around the calf's head or if you want to pull both legs simultaneously.
- 4. The calf puller should be taken apart and cleaned thoroughly after each use.
- 5. To release under tension, it is necessary to release and move backwards one catch at a time.
- 6. The following accessories are available from Jorgensen Laboratories and will ease your effort in pulling calves:
 - a. J 24-WL or J 24-WS, 60-inch or 30-inch plated steel chains.
 - b. J109, J-Lube lubrication jelly.
 - c. J 99-S Cable type head snare.
