We are in receipt of your request for a Material Safety Data Sheet (MSDS) for the Playskool Play-Doh material.

The testing, which was performed by our Quality Assurance Department or other vendor laboratories, indicates that the compound is non-toxic nor a hazardous material. Question

What are the ingredients in Play-Doh?

Play-Doh is primarily a mixture of water, salt and flour. It does NOT contain peanuts, peanut oil or any milk byproducts. Play-Doh does not contain latex. Play-Doh is non-toxic. However, children or adults who are allergic to wheat gluten or specific food dyes may have an allergic reaction to this product. Furthermore, if a dog ingests Play-Doh, due to its salt content, please contact your veterinarian immediately.

Because Play-Doh is non-toxic, non-flammable and non-reactive, no Material Safety Data Sheet (MSDS) is required for Play-Doh.
